Girls Basketball

- ◆ The 7th grade B team currently has 6 players due to 2 withdrawals. Will work on recruiting at Ice Cream Social
- ◆ Assessment process went well, good evaluators – gave each a gift card as a “thank you”
- ◆ Gym time at St. Max and Mt. Zion going well

Winter Sports

- ◆ Registration is due Wednesday, Sept. 14th
- ◆ Boys basketball – need to schedule gym time in case an assessment is needed. Will look into time availability at St. Max during the last week of Sept.
- ◆ Need to register number of teams for boys basketball with CYO by Oct. 7th

Gym Status

- ◆ Mt. Zion – scheduled for 3 girls basketball teams and 3 boys basketball teams through March
- ◆ Working on a contract with Landmark:
 - Would provide practice space for 6 boys basketball teams
 - Practice space for 6 girls volleyball teams
