

SGCS Booster Meeting Minutes

January 29, 2007

Secretary's report – minutes from last meeting were reviewed briefly and are available as always on the Boosters page of the school website

Treasurer's report – Tony shared the balance statement from the checking account.

Spiritwear - Much of the financial report dealt with the excess inventory of the spiritwear and creative ideas about how to continue to push it. Angie E. has agreed to head this up for us, and Kathy C. is helping her.

Fundraiser Updates –

- We've been asked again to coordinate the dessert sale for one night of the St. Max fish fry – Connie M. has offered to coordinate and will get out a flyer asking for donations.
- Flower sale – forms are out, and are slowly coming back in. Kathy is calling people who ordered last year who did not yet order this year to remind them. We decided this year not to copy the order form and put it in St. Max's bulletin, instead there is a notice running in the bulletin and order forms available in the back of church, as Kathy found very few orders last year that actually were returned from the bulletin (she can tell by the color of the paper).

Banquet Update – Kathy C. and Connie M. have offered to plan the banquet. Teri Dean will be assisting with awards. We need to determine whether we need to order additional letters this year or whether current inventory will carry us through one more year. Teri will work to find where we have stored the letters, and Tony needs to determine how many first time athletes we have.

Boys Basketball – A question was asked how late in the season you can add a player – CYO says until the 6th game of the season. Rich K. will set up a meeting of basketball coaches to determine how to handle the two weeks we can't get into Landmark due to their tournament. A reminder to coaches that for the CYO tournament, they need to pay the refs up front and then be reimbursed. CYO will determine seeds for their tournament after 8 games. Games that were snowed out the weekend in January will not be rescheduled (this affected only volleyball teams for us, not basketball teams who played on Saturday of that weekend).

Spring Coordinator needed – Rich C. offered to handle this unless there were other volunteers. As there were not, the Board approved. Girls in the 6th grade want to play softball, which is not really enough for a team. Tom Y. will call the girls who played last

year who have not yet signed up, Teri offered to contact a couple of 5th grade parents whose daughters were interested in playing. Names need to be to Rich by Feb 12 to allow time to determine if we have enough for a team prior to the CYO meeting. Rich asked Tom to submit a softball budget, also by Feb 12 if possible, so we have enough time to make decisions about uniforms.

Pictures – Will be taken in 15 minute increments at school if we can find a night that is available. Mike L. will work this with Joe E. Tim B. is the new photographer. Mike asked him to price the pictures without a cut going to Boosters as we don't want to use this as a fundraiser.

Volunteers Needed – we need a new Uniform Coordinator as Patty H.'s youngest child will graduate in May.
