I am excited to share with you the Ohio Music Content Standards. The reason for my excitement is that not every state has completed “music” standards. Your children will be learning from a clear, rigorous curriculum developed by top music educators.

In the primary grades we will begin our studies with basics such as beat, rhythm, and melody. Students will demonstrate sources of a wide variety of sounds, first high and low, same and different, and later will go on to identify selected music instruments (e.g., flute, trumpet, guitar, violin, piano, congas, and bagpipes). Carl Orff, a famous composer/educator, believed children learned musical concepts through movement. Therefore, many music activities will incorporate movement to solidify understanding.

I am here to help your child broaden their knowledge of music. We will accomplish this through singing, playing instruments, creating, moving, and composing. You can help your child discover these and other aspects of music in many ways, from attending concerts or providing private lessons or listening to your favorite music at home.
