Uno:

Dos:

Listening: Students will be able to identify and translate words they hear. They will also act out commands and words that have motions.

Tres:

Reading: Students will be able to read and translate short sentences, questions and individual words.

Cuatro:

Writing: Students will learn how to spell Spanish words and express themselves in simple sentences using verbs like to be, to want, to like and to have.

Cinco:

Culture: Students will learn about Spanish and Mexican holidays and traditions.
