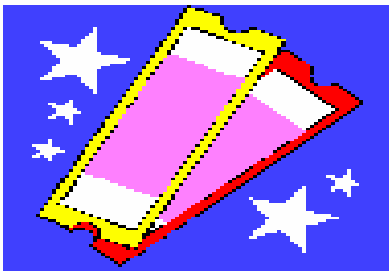

LABELS FOR EDUCATION & KROGER - BIG NEWS!! Use your Kroger Plus Card and **electronically collect Campbell's Label's points for SGCS!!** This is another PAINLESS fundraiser! Anyone can easily raise funds for SGCS - even grandparents, relatives, and friends in other cities and states. Kroger has stores in many locations across the USA.

The easiest way to create an account for electronic collection of points from eligible products purchased at Kroger is to sign your Kroger Plus Card up with Campbell's Labels for Education through the "www.elabelsforeducation.com" website. Make sure the "e" is at the beginning of the text. Just searching on "labels for education" on the web doesn't get you to the right site.

Make sure points are designated to Saint Gabriel Consolidated School. If you have questions, contact Cheryl B, School Secretary.

Don't shop at Kroger or don't use the Kroger Plus Card? Don't worry! The traditional method of clipping and saving Campbell's labels (or just the UPC) still works! Send those labels to the office, or bring to school and put in the container shaped like a Campbell's Soup Can at the flag door entrance, throughout the school year.
