Projects

Second Trimester: Read a biography (at least two hundred pages, about a person born at least 100 years ago). Complete worksheets, present to the class in the form of a Google Slides presentation by the end of the trimester.

Third Trimester: Read a "classic" novel. Complete worksheets, write a five paragraph paper about the theme, and create a physical component to go along with it.
